Dear Sirs

I hereby confirm that Standard Bank de Angola, SA, has commitment to Anti – Money Laundering and Terrorist Financing Law.

The Bank, the Board of Directors and all the Employees are committed to ensure full compliance with all applicable regulations, laws, policies and procedures and any other rules regarding AML/FT, such as:

- AML Law;
- Money Laundering and Terrorist Financing Control Policy;
- Terrorist Financing Law;
- Compliance Risk Management Policy;
- Risk Matrix;
- Sanctions Policy;
- Anti bribery and Corruption
- KYC Process Approval;
- Suspicious and Unusual Transactions Manual.

The Compliance Department is responsible for ensuring that the Bank:

- Keeps its AML/FT Policy current and each operating area implements and maintains procedures and Systems to prevent, detect and report possible money laundering and suspicious activity;
- Fully complies with applicable AML/FT Law and regulations;

The Compliance Department has authority that the AML/FT practices and procedures are consistent with the AML/FT policy and reasonable designed to satisfy the requirements of the policy and related regulatory requirements.

The Bank develops training for all the employees and is designed to familiarize employees to identify possible signs of money laundering that could arise, and their rule of compliance.

The Bank has also the concept of "Know Your Customer" and "Know Your Business" rules, such as obtain the required customer information, maintain records for a period of 10 years, and also check that if the customer, shareholders and legal representative not appear on any list of designated entities or list that known and suspected terrorist or terrorist organization (UNSC, OFAC, HMT, EU, MINEFI and etc.).

At last, we do confirm that as part of AML Policy we do have other policies to complement the execution of all Angolan Laws regarding the Anti-money Laundering and all related matters (included Probity Law).
